



Additional information and guarantee on the Copyright transfer for TRA2014

1. The copyright transfer is needed to allow IFSTTAR to publish the papers in the e-proceedings of the conference and ISTE/J. Wiley to publish thematic volumes, as decided by the TRA2014 PC and MC. The Copyright intends to avoid IFSTTAR infringing any previous IPR.

2. The Copyright form is a standard one, which was checked and approved by the PC and the legal service of ITSE/J. Wiley and IFSTTAR. It is already signed by almost all the authors, and therefore cannot be modified at this late stage.

3. However, IFSTTAR does not need any exclusivity on the Copyright after the conference, i.e. after the publication of the proceedings. It means that the authors remain free to submit their papers after the conference to any journal or other support for publication. It also means that any organisation can publish after the conference (on their web site, newsletter or any other support) the papers of their staff or of works and projects funded by them. All the authors remain free to re-use part or all of their paper's content (e.g. text or illustration) for any other publication or purpose.

If for any of these future publications, IFSTTAR's permission is asked because of the transfer of Copyright, it will be given automatically and without condition.

The aim of this copyright is not to refrain the publication of the papers but to protect IFSTTAR against any suspicion of IPR violation.

4. If some authors decide not to sign the transfer of Copyright, their papers will neither be published in the TRA2014 proceedings, nor in the thematic volumes. However the authors will be allowed to present a poster on their work.
